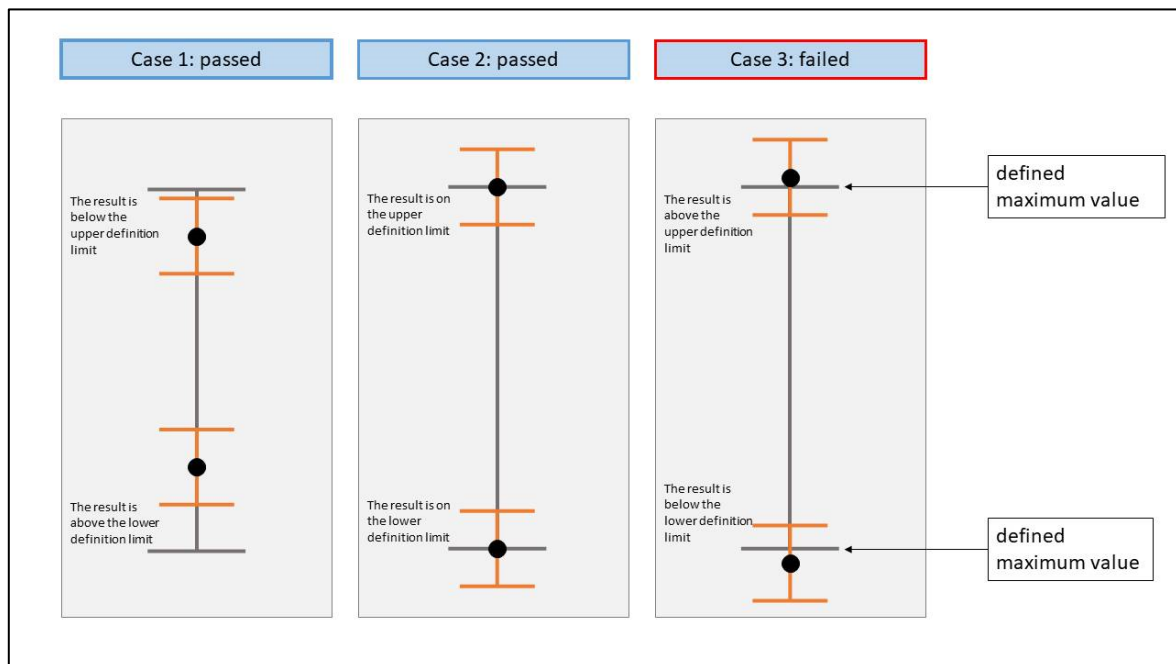




With the help of a defined decision rule, Grasse Zur Composite Testing makes a conformity statement according to specified requirements. If no requirements are specified in standards or if there are no specified requirements on the part of the customer, Grasse Zur Composite Testing applies the following decision rule to evaluate the conformity:



The defined limit values of test parameters are taken from the applicable standard, a specification or the customer's information and are specified in the test report. They must be fixed before the start of order processing and may not be changed. If a decision rule specified by the customer is applied, this must also be included in the test report and determined before order processing.

The evaluation of the results is based on minimum, maximum and average values. A distinction is made between "pass" and "fail". The measurement uncertainty is not used to evaluate the result, but is recorded for each test and included in the test report at the customer's request.
